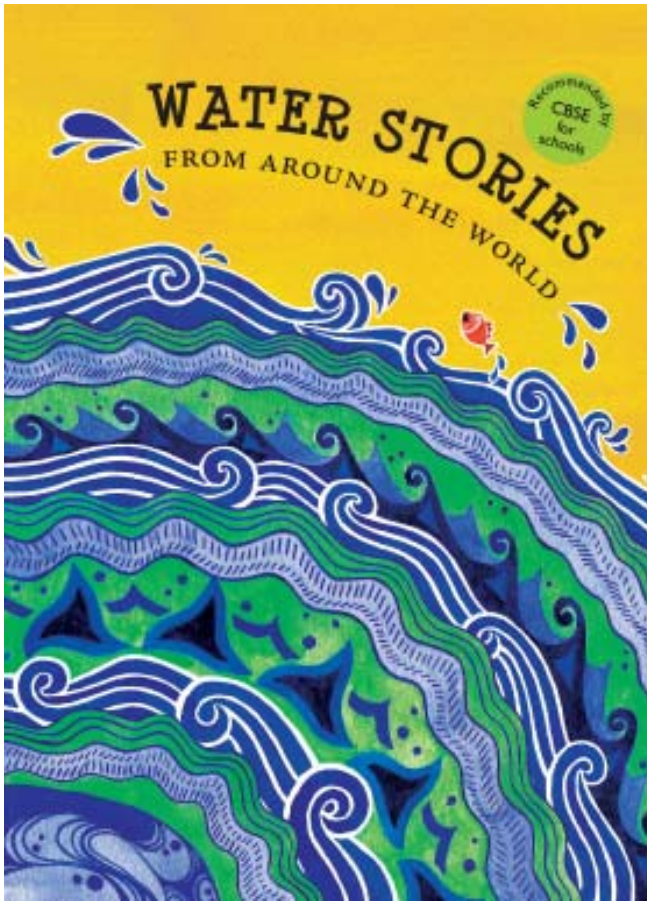

About the book

This is a collection of 11 stories on the theme of water, based on less known oral myths and folklore from around the world. The stories (from China, India, Greece, Ivory Coast, Australia, North America, Spain, Nigeria, Botswana and places beyond names) are retold with a contemporary feel by the following well-known writers: Deepa Balsavar, Suniti Namjoshi, Mariam Karim-Ahlatat, Zai Whitaker, Radhika Chadha, Sowmya Rajendran, Niveditha Subramaniam, and Sandhya Rao.

The book also has a water timeline that provides a visual history of water since c. 10,000 BC and a section dedicated to interesting and important facts about water. All these together offer an important resource both in the classroom and at home.
